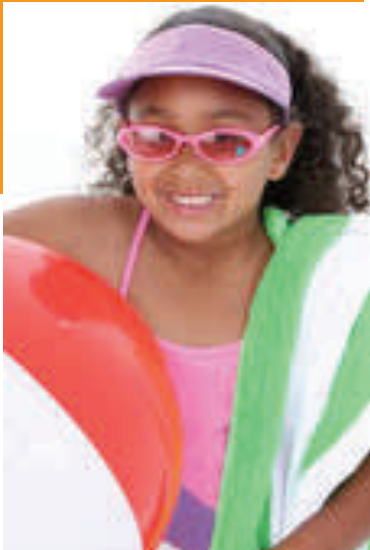

We have a fun-filled summer planned for your child. We hope you enjoy your summer as much as we do at SMS Camp.

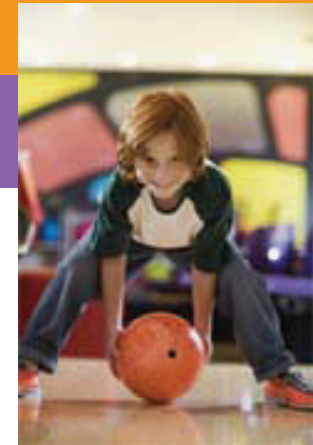
